then your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will be bursting with wine.



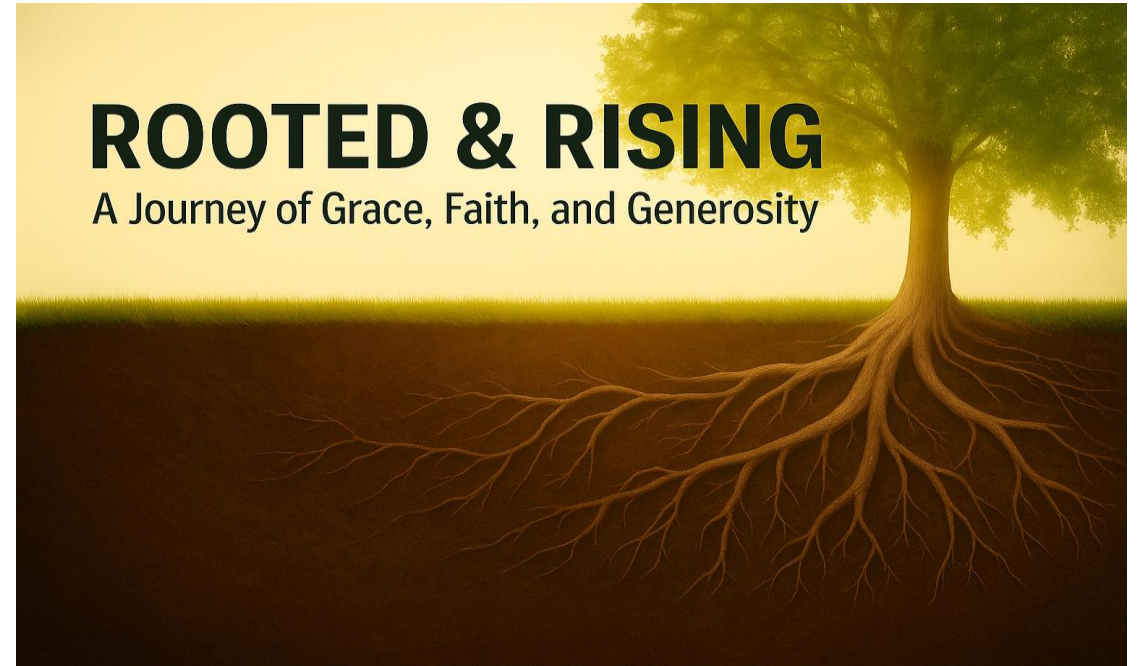
