and saw my works for forty years.

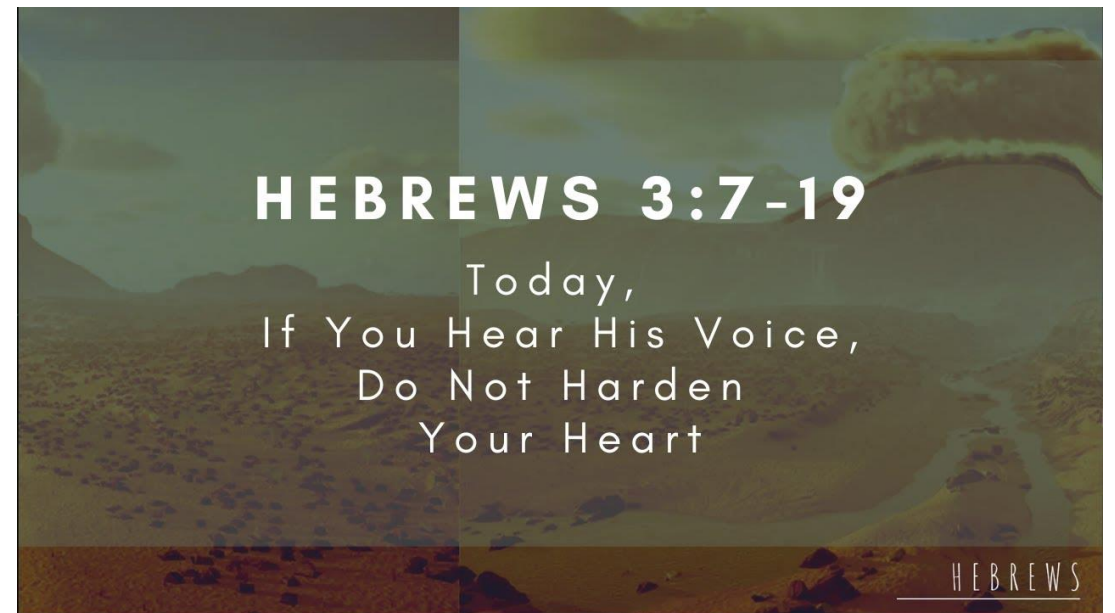
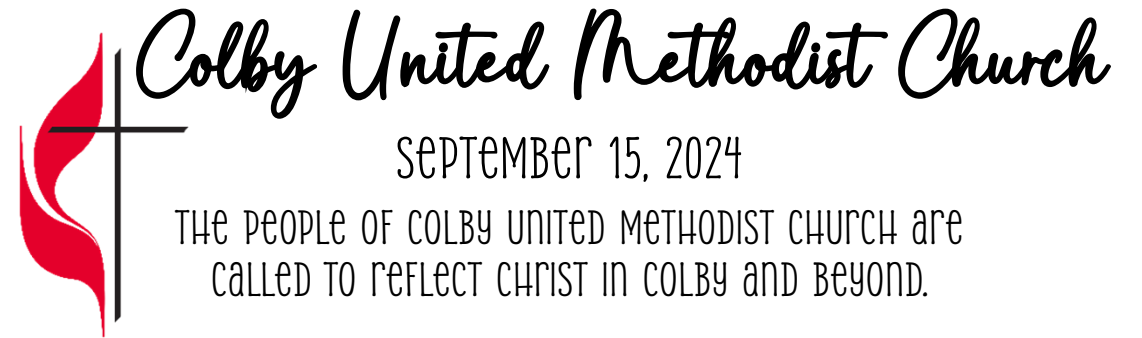
Therefore I was provoked with that generation,
